



Ohio Section Institute of Transportation Engineers Scholarship Information Academic Year 2013-2014

This scholarship is offered by the Ohio Section of the Institute of Transportation Engineers to promote the advancement of the transportation profession by providing financial assistance to students pursuing degrees in transportation engineering or other related fields.

Scholarship Award

The Ohio Section will award up to two (2) scholarships, namely a \$2000 award for the James A. Bixby Memorial Scholarship and a \$1000 award for the ITE Ohio Section scholarship, each to be applied to school tuition during the current academic year. Scholarship awards will be presented at the Ohio Section Annual Meeting to be held in Columbus, Ohio in November. Recipients will be notified prior to the awards ceremony. A check will be issued jointly to the university and the recipient upon providing proof of enrollment.

Eligibility Requirements

Student applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

- Full-time undergraduate or graduate student enrolled at an ABET accredited college or university in the State of Ohio
- Candidate must be pursuing a degree in civil engineering, transportation engineering, transportation planning, or other transportation related fields that support the goals of ITE
- GPA of 2.5 or higher

Candidates will be evaluated based on academic performance, educational plans, career goals, extracurricular activities, and work experience. Evaluations will be made on the basis of a completed application and a recommendation form provided by a faculty member, faculty advisor or employer. Special consideration will be given to student members of the Ohio Section of ITE. Membership applications are available at www.ohioite.org and may be submitted with scholarship applications. The ITE Ohio Section Scholarship Committee reserves the right to recommend that no scholarship award be given if no meritorious applications are received.

Application Instructions

To apply for the ITE Ohio Section Scholarship, the student candidate must complete and return the Scholarship Application Form and university transcript no later than **November 4, 2013**.
