(as seen in the June 2006 Civil Engineering News)



The diverging diamond interchange directs vehicle to the left side of the road to facilitate merging to and from the interstate. Traffic Signals will be placed where the arterial lanes cross and at left turns on the interstate's off-ramps.

From I-75 /71 North

At end of Brent Spence Bridge, take Second Street exit. Follow signs to Pete Rose Way. Turn left on Pete Rose Way. Follow Pete Rose Way for 4/10 mile, OKI is on the left and parking is on the right in the Sawyer Point parking lot.

From I-75 South
